



2012 Call for Industry-Academia Collaboration Posters: A Celebration of Industry Involvement in Capstone Design

Industry-Academia Collaboration Posters

As the theme of the 2012 Capstone Design conference is "Industry Involvement in Capstone Design", the organizing committee is offering another way for Industry to become involved in the conference. We invite submissions of poster abstracts that showcase collaborations between industry and academia in Capstone Design. This poster session will focus on applications of capstone projects and on successful collaborations between academia and industry.

Posters should have at least one non-academic author. Poster abstracts should include a description of the collaboration, including an explanation of industry involvement, in 300-500 words. These abstracts will be peer reviewed, and accepted abstracts will appear in the conference proceedings. There are not academic papers associated with the Industry-Academia Collaboration track.

Accepted authors will then present their poster in one of several highly interactive posters sessions at the conference in Champaign-Urbana, IL, on May 30-June 1, 2012. Poster guidelines and formatting details are given in the **poster guidelines** ([Word version](#), [PDF version](#)).

Authors will also have the opportunity to share their poster on the conference website after the conference.

Submission: Poster abstracts for the Industry-Academia Collaboration track must be submitted through the [Conference Management Tool](#) (CMT), and should adhere to the [Abstract Template](#) format. The submission deadline for these poster abstracts is March 15, 2012, and authors will be notified of acceptances by April 1, 2012.
