

#11003: Coaching Your Students to Create and Deliver Effective Presentations

Although professional life requires us all to give presentations, few receive adequate training in doing it well. In this symposium we will investigate:

(1) how to create engaging, content-rich, well-organized talks supported by strong visual materials and (2) how to deliver them with dynamism, authenticity, and authority. The workshop will include both lecture-demonstration and participation. Experiential components are designed to maximize skill acquisition; participants will have the opportunity to practice vocal and nonverbal communication techniques and learn strategies for coaching students. A training model will be offered and numerous handouts will be provided.
